

Nationalism and the break-up of the UK

Two leading industry experts have come together to discuss nationalism and what could eventually lead to the break-up of the UK.

From Brexit to the handling of the Covid-19 pandemic, the differences between England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland have never been so clear, with the 'United' Kingdom feeling increasingly divided.

With the support for a second Scottish independence referendum increasing, questions surround the future of the Union, and if Wales and Northern Ireland could eventually also decide to go their own way.
